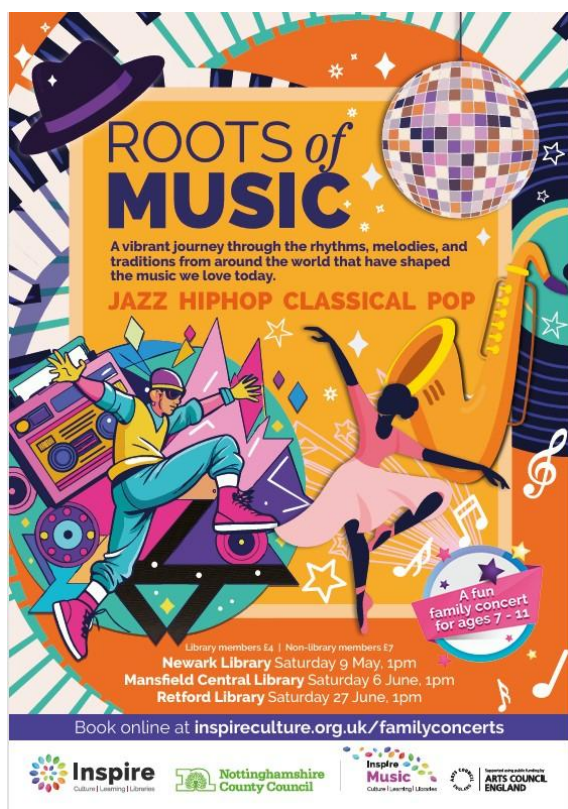


Donation of Tomato Plants
